Subject: Migration of National Scholarship Portal (NSP) – Academic Year 2026–27 from “One Student–One Scholarship framework” to the revised “One Student–Multiple Scholarships framework.”

NOTICE

All eligible students are hereby informed that, with effect from Academic Year 2026–27, the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) has migrated from the earlier “One Student–One Scholarship” framework to the revised “One Student–Multiple Scholarships” framework.

Under the revised framework, an eligible student may avail one Merit-based Scholarship along with multiple Welfare-based Scholarships, subject to the eligibility criteria and guidelines of the respective schemes.

Instructions for Students

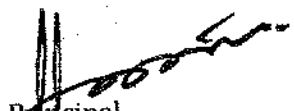
1. **Check Eligibility:** Visit the official NSP Portal (<https://scholarships.gov.in/>) and carefully check the eligibility criteria, guidelines and FAQs of the scholarship scheme(s) applicable to you.
2. **First Application:** Fill in all personal, academic, institute, course, Aadhaar and bank details correctly and upload the required documents. Verify all details carefully before final submission.
3. **Additional Scholarships:** Eligible students may apply for additional scholarships under the revised framework. For subsequent applications, scheme-specific details and relevant documents will generally be required.
4. **Defective Applications:** If an application is marked “Defective,” students should check the reason and make the required correction before resubmission. If changes are required in general or academic details, the submitted application(s) may first have to be withdrawn.
5. **Verification:** Students must ensure that their personal and academic information is correct and consistent across applications. Any deficiency in general or academic details may affect other applications during verification and may result in a “Red Flag.”
6. **Track Application:** Students should regularly check the NSP Portal for application status, defects, verification, corrections and other notifications and respond promptly wherever required.

Important

- Applicants must obtain the prescribed Undertaking Form from the College before applying for any scholarship through the NSP.
- For further details and assistance, students may contact the Convener, Scholarship Committee, Institution Nodal Officer (INO), or Assistant Scholarship Officer of the College.
- Students are advised to follow the official NSP guidelines and FAQs and submit their applications within the prescribed timeline.
